CALLING ALL DIVERS

Join the Marine Conservation Society Challenge at Vobster Quay 21st April 2007

Vobster Quay Inland Diving are having a Coastal Challenge fundraising day on April 21st 2007 to raise money for the Marine Conservation Society and help reach their challenge target of 11,477 miles. Participants are invited to swim sponsored laps around Vobster Quay (approximate distance 1 km, taking roughly 1 hour).

ITS ALL IN A GOOD CAUSE!

The MCS Coastal Challenge campaign is raising awareness across the country of a wide range of marine issues close to the hearts of many divers, including SeaSearch and the 'Marine Reserves Now' campaign to include marine conservation in the forthcoming UK Marine Bill. The MCS will be on site during the day with details of other activities and programmes for divers to get involved in marine conservation in their area, or provide a diversion for any family members who come along.

PRIZES AND SCENERY!

In addition, Vobster Quay will donate a portion of participants' entrance money to MCS. Prizes will be given at the end of the day for fastest lap (DPV and non DPV categories), most laps and best Sea Monster Challenger SMB to help spectators track the progress of participants. Keep an eye on our website for more details closer to the day. The swim will take participants through the most picturesque diving at Vobster and some rarely visited areas. The 'far side' of Vobster is home to gentle slopes, terraces at 12m and 6m, a flooded forest and secluded swim through. The route offers interest at all depths from a gentle 3m down to an adventurous 30m.

SIMPLE TO ENTER!

Entry is simple. Just print out a sponsorship form from the Vobster website and ask your friends to sponsor you for each lap - we reckon two in the day would be impressive, but if you're feeling strong or dedicated, why not try a few more? You can swim at any depth (even 1m or at the surface!) or enter as a group. To make life easy, you can even set up your own sponsor site at www.justgiving.co.uk for maximum publicity. Get more than £100 on your form and we'll let you in for free on the day too - just bring it along to the gate.
